#### Preface:

According to the letter no. 1 to 4 mentioned above by the Director of Technical Education from the academic year 2021-22, new courses in non-grant Institutes of existing Pharmacy courses in the state, increasing admission capacity of the existing courses, etc. Issuance of Government Resolutions as per permission of Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi. The matter has been proposed for Government approval.

As proposed by Director of Technical Education, from the academic year 2021-22, As shown in front of the name of the Institutes in Annexure "A", new course, in the non-granted institute of the existing Pharmacy course from the academic year 2021-22, increase in the admission capacity of the existing courses etc. The matter was under consideration of the Government for approval as per the permission of the Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi.

### Government Decision

In accordance with the approval given by the Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi, as proposed by the Director, Technical Education, from the academic year 2021-22 in the accompanying Annexure "A". Existing permanent unaided Pharmacy Degree, as shown in front of the name of the institute, Initiation of new courses in postgraduate institutes, increase in existing admission capacity etc. The matter is being approved by the government subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1) This sanction will remain on permanent non-grant basis.
- 2) In the present case the organization concerned will be bound to fulfill the conditions prescribed by the All India Council of Technical Education and also prescribed by the Government Resolution dated May 21, 1983. The admission capacity of the institute for this course will be as mentioned above.
- 3) All the terms and conditions prescribed by the All India Council of Technical Education New Delhi and also prescribed by the Government / Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi. Also the relevant documents and formalities will be fulfilled satisfactorily with the consent of the Director of Technical Education, Maharashtra State.
- 4) The concern Institution should pay the required accumulated deposit to the Director, Technical Education in the joint account and fulfill other legal matters.

5. Admission of this Degree and Postgraduate Degree course approved by the Government Admission to the course will be done as per rules / method.
6. If the concerned Institutions charge more than the tuition fees prescribed by the Fees Regulatory Authority, action will be taken against those institutions as per Maharashtra Education Institutions (Prohibition of Capitation Fees) Act, 1987.
7. The Institute should appoint full time teachers and others Technical staff to run the course as per Government rules regarding salaries and allowances.
8. It is necessary to purchase the books and periodicals required by the library of the Institute as per the standards of All India Council of Technical Education. Also, in order for the students to make full use of the library, it is necessary to provide study facilities (e.g. laboratory, library, classroom etc.) as per the standards of All India Council of Technical Education.
9. Regarding ragging, Hon. Strict implementation of Supreme Court directives and Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging 1999 will be required.

1. In addition the Director of Technical Education, State of Maharashtra, Mumbai related Universities. The other terms and conditions given will remain applicable.
2. Institutions which have not paid the processing fee to the Director of Technical Education, State of Maharashtra should recover it before final approval by the Director of Tantra Education for inclusion of the course in the centralized admission process as per this Government approval.
3. Education should issue the necessary orders within the next 10 days.
