
Last but not least the valedictory function was organised where Principal Dr. Sunita Ogale explained the importance of pharmacy in the whole world. The results for all the events were

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

Report: Industrial Visit to Korten Pharmaceuticals

Date- 17-02-2023

Venue- Korten Pharmaceuticals, Palghar

The third year students of Viva Institute of Pharmacy visited industry-Korten Pharmaceuticals, Palghar accompanied by, Mrs. Sushruta Mulay and Ahisha Kolapkar Professor of Pharmaceutics, Korten Pharmaceuticals is a major industry in the production of parenteral, nasal drops, and eye drops.

The students were introduced to HVAC (Heating Ventilation Air Conditioning) consisting of AHU (Air Handling Unit) responsible for circulation and distribution of air in the plant. Steps in purification of water such as de-ionization, ultrafiltration were in. Various sections visited were parenteral preparation area, quality control Area, Sterilization area, filling and sealing area, packaging and labelling areas etc. Students got to know there are two ways to prepare parenteral in this industry, first is in aseptic condition and second is terminal sterilization. A separate section of nasal drops packaging, filling, sealing etc. was seen. The students also learnt about the raw material storage area and the role of QA and QC in their sampling and approval. Evaluation of ampoules for particulate matter is done with 3 different methods in the industry which was shown by the staff. Overall, this visit was a chance for the students to get a hands- on information about the general working of the parenteral industry.
