Event description:

This report consist of 16 pages.

The National Service Scheme (NSS) unit at VIVA Institute of Pharmacy and VIVA Institute of Technology jointly arranged a seven days special residential camp from 02nd March 2024 to 08th March 2024 at Makwana farmhouse, Usgaon, At post. Bhatane, Virar (E). Total of 50 NSS volunteers along with 2 NSS senior volunteers, NSS PO and female faculty accompanied the camp from pharmacy. The camp was conducted successfully with learnings every day to volunteers, healthy food and no medical issues.

Following seminars were conducted during camp:

1. Seminar on “How to perform street play” by Mr. Jagdish Sansare sir.
2. Training of volunteers on “How to conduct medical health checkup camps’ by Dr. Vedati Packiam
3. Seminar on “Food adulteration and Consumer rights” by Mr. Gajanan Patil Sir.
4. Seminar on “Awareness on platelet donation” by Mr. Pratik Chavan sir
5. Seminar on “Deaddiction/ Vyasnmukti/ Nashamukti’ by Mr. Milind Patil Sir.

The details of activities conducted during each day in the seven days of camp are described further as follows:



Day 1 (02/03/2024)

Day 1 of the camp started by gathering of volunteers at 8.30 am to college campus. The baggages of the volunteers were checked for packaged foods, addictive substances and any other items that would affect the integrity and respect of NSS camp. Post checking activity, volunteers departed for camp in bus at 10.00 am and reached the destination i.e, Makwana Farmhouse, Bhatane at 10.45 am. After reaching to camp site, volunteers were gathered in assembly area and detailed directions and information about the camp and activities to be conducted in camp was given to volunteers, Camp rules and regulations were explained to volunteers and consequences of defaulting the rules were also explained. Two separate apartment arrangement were made at camp site for male and female volunteers and same were directed to volunteers. At around 11.45 am mobile phones of volunteers were collected and volunteers were asked to settle in respective premises after cleaning the premises and have lunch which they had carried along with them from home. After the lunch at 2.00 pm volunteers were asked to gather in assembly hall for inauguration of the camp. The Inauguration of the camp was done by Bhau kaka (Senior citizen of the village). Post inauguration ice-breaking and team building activity. Three teams were prepared viz, Kitchen team, Cleaning team and Street play team which were swapped on daily basis upto seven days. After team formation, kitchen team proceeded for making high tea and dinner planning. High tea was served at 5.30 pm by the kitchen team. After high tea a session was conducted by POs Mr. Sushil Mishra and Mr. Aakash B. Makwana, where both explained the basics of NSS diary to the volunteers and volunteers were asked to sung NSS lakshya geet and also to fill NSS diary regularly upto seven days. Post this day review meeting was conducted and dinner was served by kitchen team at around 8.30 pm which completed by 9.30 pm. At 9.30 am next day's planning was explained to volunteers and were asked to reach sharp at 6.00 am to assembly hall for yoga and PT sessions. With this instructions day 1 concluded and lights were off by 10.00 pm.

Day 2 (03/03/2024)

Day start: 6.00 am

2nd day started at 6.00 am with yoga session and PT sessions for cleaning and street play teams. Yoga session was taken by Miss. Akshita Patankar and PT session was taken by Master. Mohit Patil. Meanwhile kitchen team was undergoing preparations for breakfast. After completion of yoga and PT session volunteers went for jogging and returned back at 7.45 am-8.00 am. Kitchen team served breakfast at 8.00 am which completed around 9.00 am. After completion of breakfast, cleaning team was asked to clean the assembly hall and street play team was given time for personal hygiene from 9.00 am to 10.00 am. From 10.00 am to 10.45 am personal hygiene time was allotted to cleaning team and simultaneously street play team started preparation for street play session which was planned to start at 11.15 am. Meanwhile street play team was asked to prepare and practice for street play to be conducted in adopted village. At 4.45 pm high tea was served by kitchen team and then with full enthusiasm and excitement street play team went to adopted villages Navsai and Talachya pada for performing street play on importance of voting and participation in election through vote. Some members of cleaning team accompanied street play team for crows gathering. Street play team returned back to camp site at 6.45 pm. Thereafter street play team, cleaning team along with some members of kitchen team started with cultural event in which participant sung folk music using instruments. At 8.00 pm dinner was served by kitchen team which completed at round 9.00 pm. Post completion of dinner review meeting was conducted and next day planning was done. At 9.30 pm mobile phones were distributed to volunteers for 15 mins to have communication with parents. After collecting mobile phones back and cleaning of complete kitchen along with kitchen utensils day concluded with lights off 10.20 pm.

3rd day started at 6.00 am with yoga session and PT sessions for cleaning and street play teams. Yoga session was taken by Miss. Akshita Patankar and PT session was taken by Master. Mohit Patil. Meanwhile kitchen team was undergoing preparations for breakfast. After completion of yoga and PT session volunteers went for jogging and returned back at 7.45 am-8.00 am. Kitchen team served breakfast at 8.00 am which completed around 9.00 am. Street play and cleaning team was given time of personal hygiene from 9.00 am to 10.00 am. At 9.00 am Dr. Vedati Packiam and her team from health concept arrived as campsite. Hospitality of the guests was done by volunteers of kitchen team by serving tea and breakfast. At 10.00 am session on ayurvedic and homeopathic medicine medical training started for volunteers which continued upto 11.00 am. Health checkup camp concluded at 12.00 noon with total count of 50+ villagers participated for checkup. The team returned back at 1.00 pm to camp site had rest and then proceeded for lunch. After completion of lunch at 2.30 pm the guest went off and volunteer's team departed for Navsai village for distribution of free AYUSH medicines as trained by Dr. Vedati Packiam. While conducting free distribution of medicines volunteers also performed street play on importance of maintaining good health. Cleaning team performed cleaning of the campus upto 5.30 pm. At 5.30 pm street play team returned back from village. High tea was served at 5.30 pm and post that cultural event was started. Total of 5 participation were received for the cultural event.
